


Present Study

- Examined cross-lagged, bidirectional pathways from
 - (1) CG childhood abuse to...
 - (2) Depressive symptoms in adulthood to...
 - (3) Aggressive parenting
- Examined indirect effects (i.e., mediation)
- Panel data across 12 years, 6 timepoints:
 - Child age 4, 6, 8, 12, 14, and 16 years.




Conceptual Model



LONGSCAN Sample and Procedures

- Multi-site consortium of studies on causes/consequences of maltreatment
- Original sample: 1,354 children and their caregivers
 - Baseline to age 16 attrition = 38.4%
- Present study: *N* = 867



Measures

Family Demographics

Age, sex, race/ethnicity, poverty, high school, cohabitation status

Maternal History of Abuse

• Mother's History of Loss and Harm questionnaire; count of 8 items

Maternal Depressive Symptoms

Center for Epidemiologic Studies Depression Scale (CES-D)

Mothers' Abusive Parenting Strategies

Conflict Tactics Scale: Parent to Child (CTSPC)






Results

- Model Fit:
 - $X_{314}^2 = 700.12, p < .001$
 - **CFI** = 0.95
 - **TLI** = 0.91
 - **RMSEA** = 0.038, 95% CI [0.034, 0.031]








Limitations

- Unable to include abusive parenting behaviors
 - Endorsed much less frequently
- Relied on caregiver report
 - Child report and CPS data are available in LONGSCAN, with limitations
- LONGSCAN highly unique sample; may limit generalizability of findings
